

For all Summons

I have read DVA Factsheet VRB06 Summoning Witnesses or Documents and understand that I am responsible to arrange service of the witness summons.

The summons must be served personally on the witness. That means, you have to hand deliver the summons to the person for whom it is intended, with the person being shown the summons when it is handed over.

Details of service of the summons should be noted and retained in case a dispute arises as to the effective service of the summons.

For a Summons to attend

I have read DVA Factsheet VRB06 Summoning Witnesses or Documents and understand that I am responsible for providing the person summoned with reasonable expenses to travel to attend the VRB. In addition, if I summons an expert witness, I am responsible for paying the expert fees for the witness.

The travelling expenses and any witness fees are determined by the presiding member of the VRB panel, at the time the summons is issued.

Please lodge the completed Form at the VRB Registry where your application for review will be heard. Preferably the Form should be lodged at the same time as your Certificate of Readiness. At the latest, it should be lodged not less than 14 days before the hearing date.
