- You may apply for a Certificate of Entitlement or request insurance cover before a service check is completed, but we cannot issue a Notice of Eligibility or a Certificate of Entitlement until it is finalised.
- Please contact DSH before entering into a contract for your housing approval. It is important that you do this so that your entitlement to a DSH loan can be established before you incur any costs.
