## Notes - DVA Pensioner Summary - March 2011

### **Method of extraction**

The data used for this publication was extracted using "the current date" method of extraction which read data as at 1/04/2011. Please note that figures can be slightly overstated because of normal delays in processing death cases.

As noted in the March 2002 publication, extracting data by 'eligibility' alone resulted in some figures being overstated. From June 2002 onwards data is extracted on both 'eligibility' and 'payability', i.e. on the basis of a client not only being entitled to receive a benefit, but also in actual receipt of the benefit/s or payment.

### **Data integrity**

The numbers shown in the publication reflect the data currently stored in the Department's client database. Any inaccuracies existing in the publication may be attributed to data entry errors or various data conversions in the past. All due professional care is taken in correcting such errors, especially where they can be readily detected, by amending the client statistics as necessary. However, many errors are hidden within large aggregate numbers requiring extensive reconciliation and verification processes for detection. Such inconsistencies are actioned by business areas as they are detected.

### **Conflict groupings**

Significant changes have been made to tables reporting veterans by conflict. Tables 5 and 6, reporting on veterans receiving Service Pension, now include a category 'Other Post 1972 Conflicts'. This group includes Cambodia, Namibia, Rwanda, Somalia, the War in Iraq (2003) and Afghanistan.

Changes have also been made to the tables reporting on veterans receiving Disability Pension. The Second World War category now includes mariners from the Merchant Navy. Veterans who served in the Far East Strategic Reserve are now included with those who served in Korea and/or Malaya. The Vietnam group may include some veterans who served in North East Thailand. The 2003 War in Iraq, and the 2001-2003 operations in Afghanistan (previously 'War on Terror') are now reported and an additional category 'Other Operations' has been created comprising of Namibia, Cambodia, Yugoslavia and Somalia. The 'Serving Member' category refers to service men and women who were on active duty between 1972 and 1994 but did not serve in an operational area.

Those veterans who have served in more than one conflict or operational area have been included only in the earliest of those conflicts. For example, a veteran who saw service in both Korea and later Vietnam will not be included under Vietnam. Similarly, a veteran from Afghanistan who has also served in East Timor will only be included in the East Timor figure. Reports specific to any individual conflict or operation are available on request.

### **Revision**

All changes mentioned above have been made following consultation with the Policy and Development and Service Delivery Divisions. As part of an on-going review of statistical products and publications, this report will continue to be enhanced in future issues in consultation with relevant business areas.

### **Tables with "state"**

Prior to June 2009 tables with "state" were based on state of processing, not state of residence. ACT and the NT were included in the NSW and South Australian results respectively, with overseas residents included in the Tasmania figure. From June 2009 onwards residential address is used with ACT, NT and overseas reported separately.

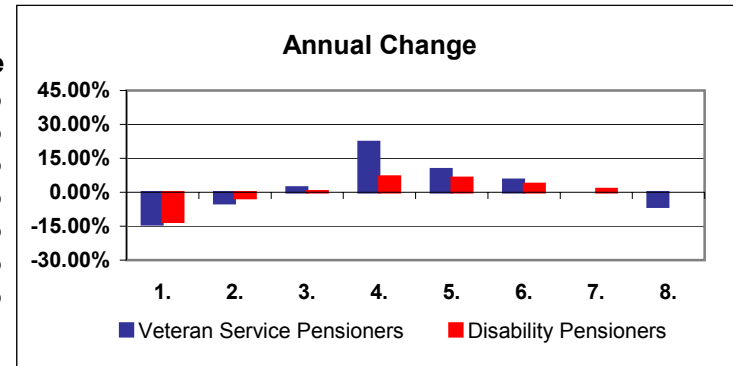

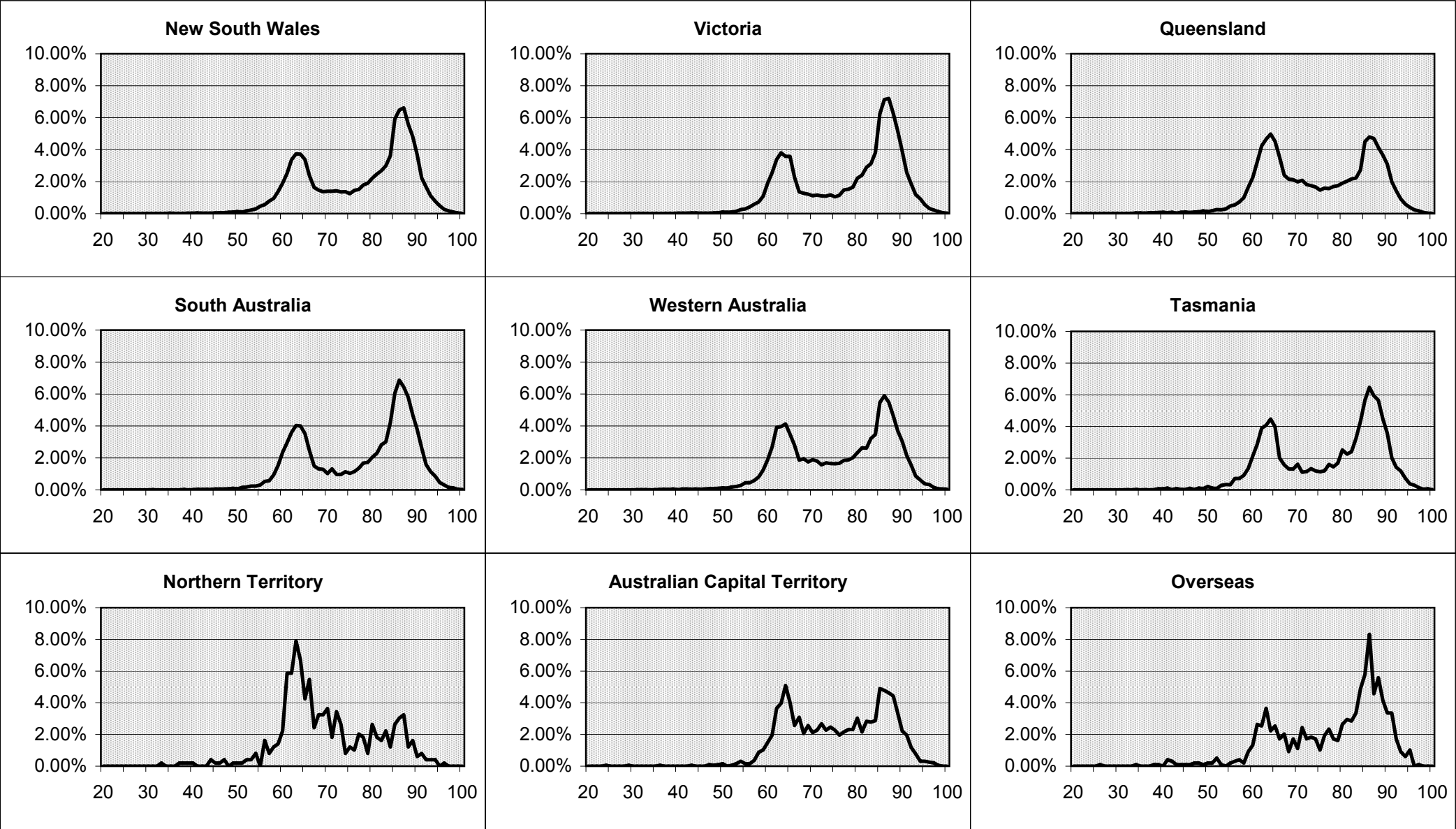

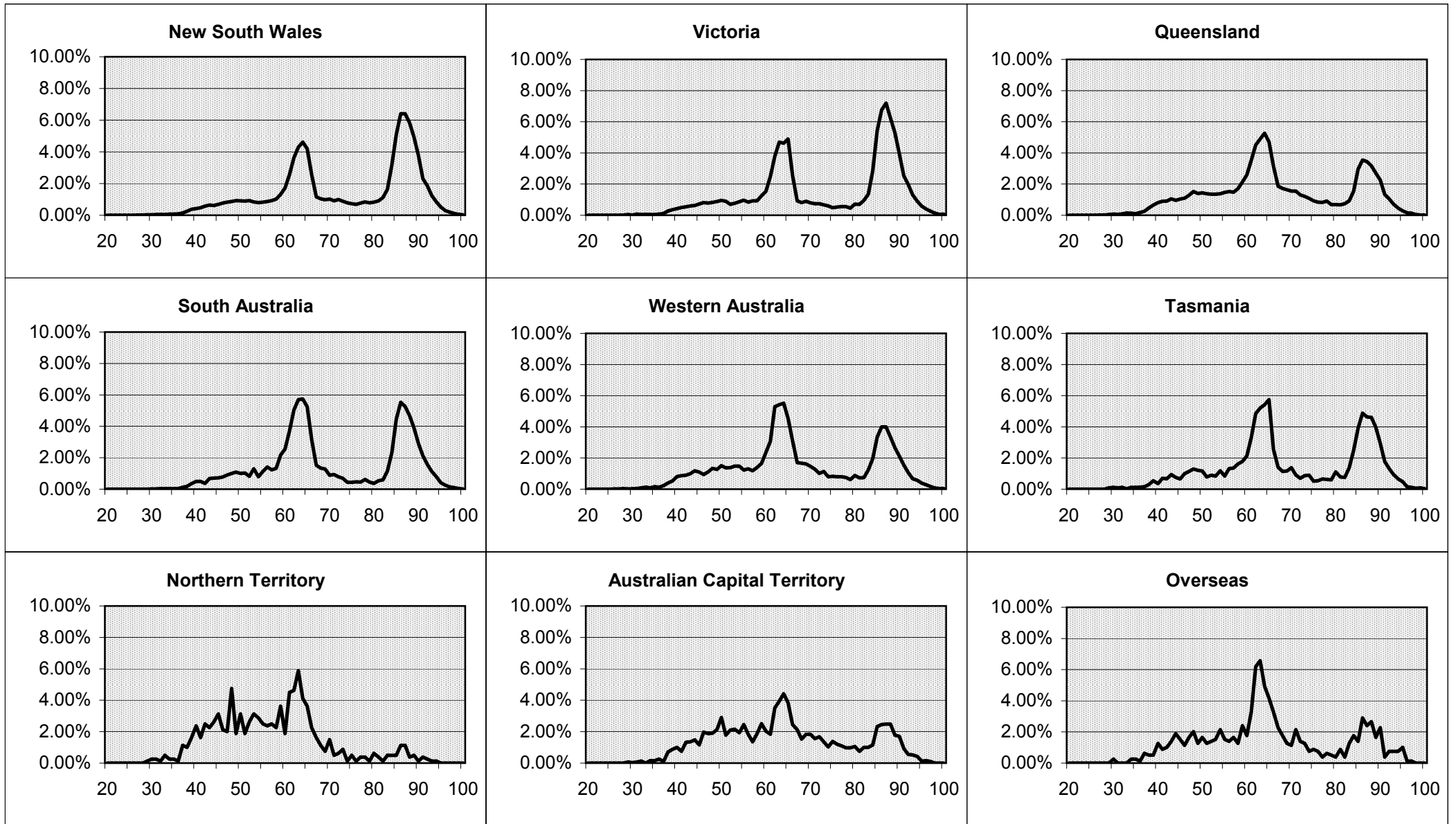

**Chart 1: Service Pensioners by State and by Age - March 2011**

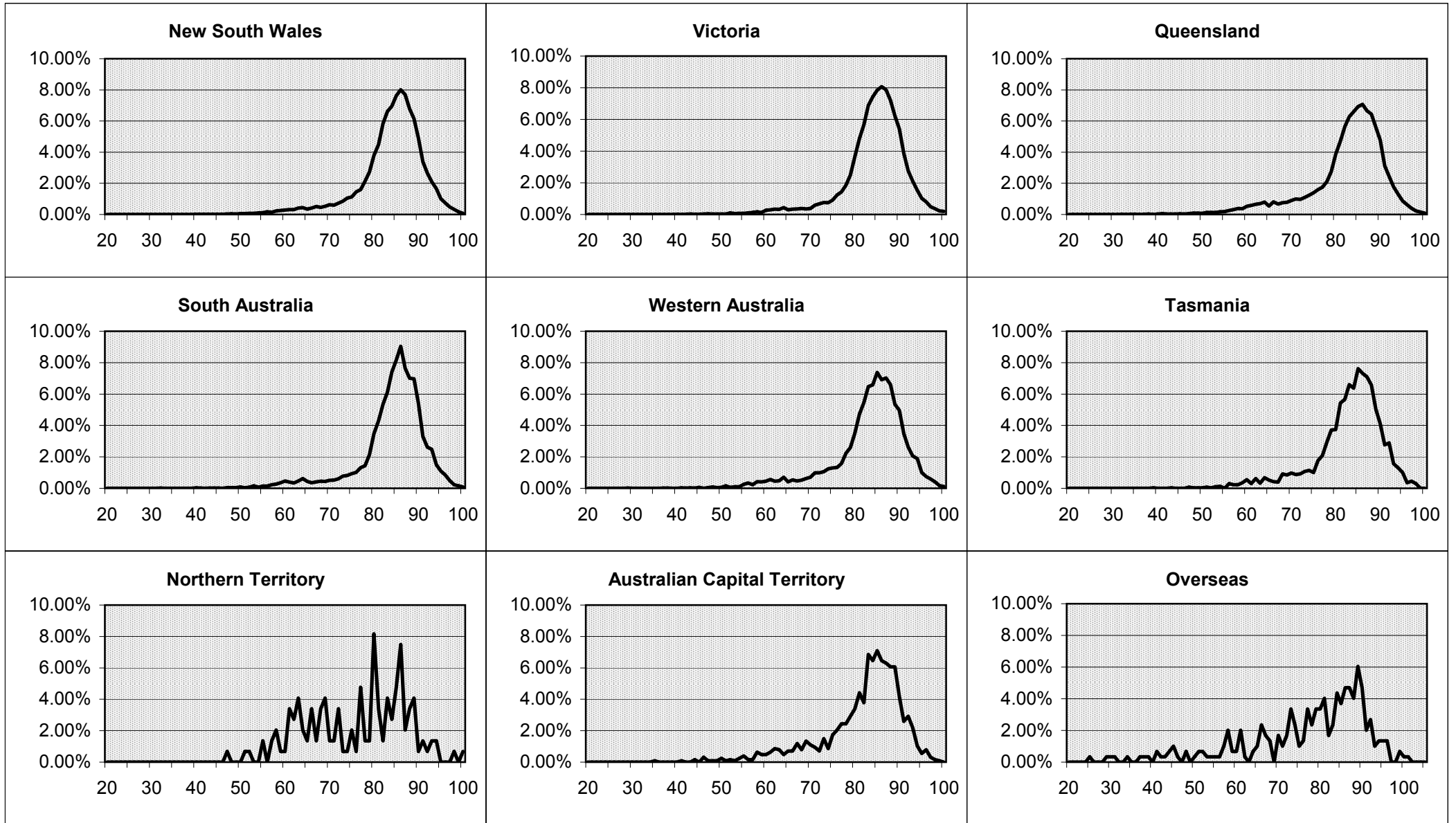


**Chart 2: Disability Pensioners by State and by Age - March 2011**

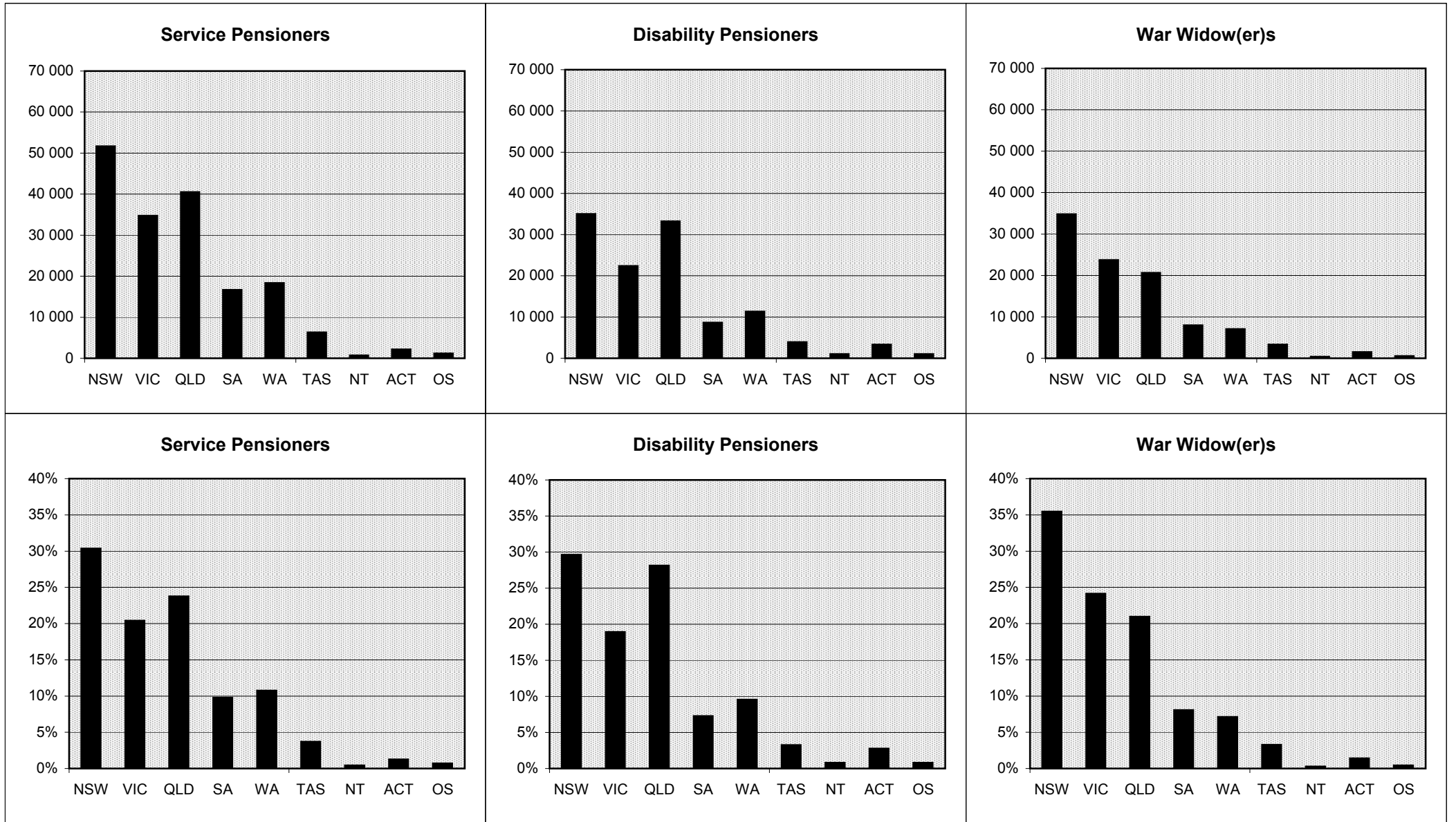




**Chart 3: War Widow(er) Pensioners by State and by Age - March 2011**
